Opening Kick...

- The JU football team returns to Appalachian State for the second time in three seasons after opening 2010 with a 35-25 win over Old Dominion on the road.
- The Dolphins enter the game having won their last four contests, which is the sixth-longest active streak in the country.
- Senior running back **Rudell Small** opened his final season with an impressive 118 yards on 19 carries with two touchdowns at Old Dominion. It is the 14th time in his career he has rushed for 100 yards in a game.
- Quarterback **Josh McGregor** and wide receiver **Josh Philpart** both earned CFPA weekly recognition for their stellar outings at Old Dominion. McGregor threw for 311 yards and three touchdowns, with two of those to Philpart who caught six passes for 115 yards.
- Last season, the JU defense did not force a turnover until the sixth game. In 2010, the Dolphins were ball hawks - forcing four turnovers in the game, with three interceptions.
- Today's game marks the sixth time in JU history that the Dolphins have faced a team ranked in the top 25. Jacksonville is 0-5 in those games, with the last being the 56-7 loss at No. 1 Appalachian State in 2008.

Slow Starters

The Dolphins have not been the greatest out of the blocks in their three seasons under **Kerwin Bell**. While JU has won its season opener in each of the last three seasons, the Dolphins have ended the month with a losing record each time. Under Bell, JU has a 4-8 record in September.

Scoring First Has Its Privileges

For just the third time in the **Kerwin Bell** era, the Dolphins were able to win a game when they didn't score first. Jacksonville is 17-7 under Bell when they score first, but improved to 3-9 when its opponents get the first points.

Record Chase Begins

Entering the 2010 season, several Dolphins have the opportunity to rewrite the record books at JU by the end of the campaign.

Josh McGregor and **Rudell Small** have already taken control of their record books. Small owns the all-time rushing yards and rushing touchdowns records while McGregor is the all-time leader in passing yards and passing touchdowns.

Looking to make their mark this season will be linebacker **Joseph Fennell** and wide receiver **Josh Philpart**.

Winning Streaks

Dolphins Roll up Points, Yards and Turnovers at Old Dominion

Jacksonville opened its 2010 season in style by rolling up 493 yards of total offense and forcing four turnovers for a 35-25 win in front of almost 20,000 at Old Dominion.

- JU won its season opener for the third straight year - all of them on the road.
- JU's 493 yards of total offense was the most by the Dolphins since 540 in the season opener at Webber International a year ago. It is the ninth time in the Kerwin Bell era that JU has posted 450 yards or more in a game.
- The Dolphins forced four turnovers in the contest, with three interceptions. Last season, JU did not force four turnovers in a game.
- **Rudell Small** posted the 14th 100-yard game of his career with 19 carries for 118 yards and two touchdowns. He also had a long run of 45 in the second quarter that led to a JU score.
- **Josh McGregor** threw for 311 yards, completing 24-of-34 passes with three touchdowns. He turned his game up a notch in the second half, completing 16-of-20 for 235 yards. The 311 yards is his fifth-highest single-game total of his career.
- **Josh Philpart** produced the fifth 100-yard receiving performance of his career, making six catches for 115 yards and two touchdowns. Philpart has now caught a pass in 20 straight games and has scored a touchdown in nine straight.
- Some of the young Dolphins made their impact felt on the defense immediately. **Jordan Dewhirst** ended Old Dominion's drive to take the lead in the fourth quarter by intercepting a pass in the end zone. **Andre Addison**, on just his second play of the game, stepped up with an interception to snuff out another deep ODU drive.

JU knocks off a scholarship foe

While the win over Old Dominion was a great way to start the season, it marked the first time since beating Savannah State in the season opener of 2008 that JU has beaten a Football Championship Subdivision scholarship opponent. Prior to that win, JU's last win over a scholarship opponent was a 14-9 victory over Coastal Carolina in 2003.

Dolphins Earn Preseason All-America Selections

Rudell Small has rewritten the record books and was named one of the top 10 running backs in the Football Championships Subdivision, as well as being named to the FCS Running Back "Performer of the Year" watch list and being nominated for the Walter Payton Award - the Heisman Trophy of the FCS.

Joining him in earning All-America honors is junior wide receiver **Josh Philpart**. Philpart was picked third team All-America in the preseason after recording a school-record 912 receiving yards as a sophomore. Senior wide receiver/punt returner **Elliott Finkley** was picked to the "Punt Return Performer of the Year" watch list.

Rounding out the preseason honors is **Josh McGregor's** nod on the "National Performer of the Year" list as well as the "Quarterback Performer of the Year."

Another JU First - Back-to-Back Winning Seasons

For the first time in the history of JU football, the Dolphins put together back-to-back winning season with a 7-4 record in 2009. Over the last two campaigns, JU has produced a 16-8 record and is 12-3 in Pioneer Football League action. In fact, JU has not lost a home game in PFL play since losing to Valparaiso on Nov. 3, 2007 - a streak of nine straight games.

Dolphins Picked to Finish Third in Tight PFL Race

Having handed defending PFL champion Butler its only loss last season and with 15 starters returning, including 10 on offense, Jacksonville has been picked to finish third in a tight race for the PFL title.

JU was one of three teams to receive first place votes, taking home four of the 10 votes to win the league. Dayton received four votes as well and finished with 76 points to earn the preseason nod to win the PFL.

Butler, with two first place votes, was picked to finish second with 69 points. JU was just one point back in third place.

"The margin in the voting shows how tight the race for the title is going to be this year," said JU head coach Kerwin Bell. "There are a lot of teams that are going into this season feeling like they can win it. You have to be ready for every game as anyone can beat you on a given day."

Drake was picked fourth, followed by San Diego, Marist, Davidson, Campbell, Morehead State and Valparaiso.

Dolphins set to be Road Warriors in 2009

The 2010 schedule could go down as one of the most difficult in the program's history - featuring six road trips, with four flights and another trip to face a national power.

Jacksonville will make three "air raids" - flying in the day of the game against Old Dominion, Morehead State and Valparaiso. JU will also fly to Butler, but will be making that trip on Friday before the game.

The Dolphins will be making two bus trips to North Carolina - facing No. 3 Appalachian State and then PFL-rival Davidson.

All told, JU will rack up 4,066 miles on the road this season.

Last Minute Wins

It's been a while since JU has put together a last minute win like the one against San Diego in 2008. **Donovan Curry's** 50-yard field goal was the first time in the history of the program that Jacksonville has won a game on a field goal in the final two minutes.

In the 12 years of JU football, the Dolphins have won on a score late in the fourth quarter seven times. The last time JU won on a score inside the final two minutes of regulation was against on a fumble recovery for a touch-down with 1:25 left against Dayton in 2006.

Here's a look at the other last-minute heroics in JU history:

Sept. 1, 2001 JU 20, Lenoir-Rhyne 16

Trailing 16-13, Jon Turner catches a 62-yard touchdown pass from Gary Cooper with 9:27 left in the game. The Dolphins get a stop and run out the clock with a 23-play drive.

Sept. 13, 2003 JU 42, Wingate 38

Rallying from 21 points down, Emmett Hunter scored on a 7-yard run with 1:11 left to cap a 10-play, 55-yard drive for the win.

Sept. 20, 2003 JU 14, Coastal Carolina 9

Mike Sturgill leads JU on a 16-play, 77-yard drive that is capped when Sturgill hits Justin Knowles on a 14-yard touchdown with 6:29 left in the game.

Sept. 27, 2003 JU 34, Valparaiso 27

The cardiac Dolphins win late again as Mike Sturgill hooks up with Eldin Ferguson on a 10-yard touchdown pass with 2:24 left in the game.

Oct. 9, 2004 JU 29, Davidson 26

Mike Sturgill used some more of his fourth quarter magic, finding Eldin Ferguson on a 15-yard touch-down pass with 31 seconds left to lift JU to a crucial PFL win.

Oct. 22, 2005 JU 33, Austin Peay 26

Steven Battle's 1-yard touchdown run with 1:25 left in the game capped a 12-play, 77-yard drive to give JU the win on the road.

Oct. 14, 2006 JU 28, Dayton 21

The Dolphins beat Dayton for the first time in program history when Mirco Zanella recovered a Rob Florian fumble and returned it seven yards for the game-winning touchdown.

Oct. 25, 2008 JU 30, San Diego 29

Donovan Curry's 50-yard field goal with 1:23 left in the game capped a 10-point rally in the final four minutes to give the Dolphins their first win over the three-time defending PFL champions.

Nov. 22, 2008 JU 19, Dayton 14

Trailing 14-0 entering the fourth quarter, Geavon Tribble's 7-yard run on a reverse with 5:00 left in the game capped an epic rally to give JU its first PFL championship.

NORFOLK, Va. - The JU football team exorcised some demons on Saturday at Foreman Field, using timely defense and an explosive offense to topple Old Dominion, 35-25, in front of a sellout crowd of 19,782.

JU (1-0) put up 493 yards of total offense, throwing for 311 yards and putting up 182 on the ground, led by Walter Payton Award candidate Rudell Small. Small had 19 carries for 118 yards and two touchdowns.

Junior wide receiver Josh Philpart did his part as well – putting up 115 yards on six receptions with two touchdowns, including the game-clinching 19-yard pass from McGregor with 1:54 left in the game.

The Dolphins young defense stood tall when it needed to all night, forcing four turnovers and stopping the Monarchs on a fourth down inside the 20 despite giving up 461 yards.

“We talked all week about getting respect after last year,” said JU head coach Kerwin Bell. “We did a lot of good things tonight, especially with our young defense that made a lot of big plays when we needed them.”

After seeing a 27-14 lead evaporate in the fourth quarter against ODU at home a year ago, the Dolphins had seen a 28-17 lead turn into a 28-25 with just 8:28 left in the game after a Thomas DeMarco one-yard run.

The JU offense had a quick 3-and-out and ODU came right back down the field – driving to the JU 11-yard line, where on 3rd-and-9, Jordan Dewhirst got in front of a DeMarco pass in the end zone and raced it out to the JU 41-yard line.
