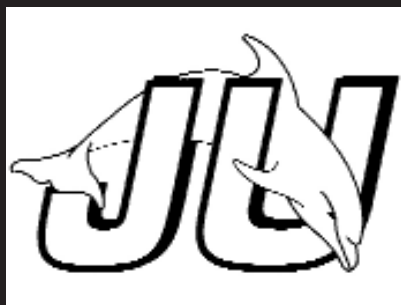

The 2011 Jacksonville University Football Media Guide is designed to aid members of the media covering Dolphin football.

We appreciate your coverage and if there is anything we can do to assist, please contact the Media Relations Office at (904) 256-7402.

The Jacksonville University Media Relations Office has certain policies and procedures that we ask for you to abide by while covering the Dolphins. These are for the benefit of your needs and those of JU's student-athletes and coaches. We ask that you please respect these requests in order to create a good working atmosphere for all parties involved.

Credentials

Credentials for all JU games are for working media only. Requests for media credentials should be made in writing on company letterhead at least five days prior to the game.

Requests should be directed to Jim Nasella, Director for Media Relations. Requests from the media covering visiting teams will be confirmed with that team's sports information director. Spouses, dates, children and other non-workers are not permitted in working media areas in compliance with the working code of the Football Writers Association of America.

Credentials can be picked up at the Will Call area at the south end of the D.B. Milne Field. Will Call will open at 10:30 a.m. for all home games.

Parking

Media parking is located on a limited basis in the North Lot adjacent to the Lazara Health Sciences Building. Requests for parking credentials should be submitted to Jim Nasella, Director for Media Relations.

At The Game

D.B. Milne Field is the site of all Dolphin football home games. The working press box is located on the east side of the stadium. All media services (statistics, telephones, game info, etc.) will be readily available at your convenience. JU grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on a reciprocal basis. Two phone lines are available for visiting radio use. These phones require collect calls or a credit card for billing.

Photographers

Jacksonville University will adhere to all NCAA Guidelines regarding sideline photog-

raphy. Photographers and videographers are not permitted to shoot between the 25-yard lines and must wear proper credentials at all times.

Post Game Interviews

Head coach Kerwin Bell and requested players will be available in the press room adjacent to the JU locker room upon request, following a 10-minute cool down period. The JU locker room will not be open to the media. Each visiting team will set its own post-game policy, and it will be announced in the press box during the fourth quarter.

Interview Policy

All JU players and coaches will be available throughout the season for interviews with members of the news media. It is important, however, that all requests for interviews be made through the Media Relations Office at (904) 256-7402. This policy allows us to arrange a time that will not interfere with a student-athlete's academic schedule, which has top priority. No player's phone number will be given out.

Daily Practices

The JU Media Relations staff encourages coverage of Dolphin football not be limited to gameday. As a general rule, all practices are open to the media and public. There may be instances, however, when all or part of a practice session is closed. Please contact the Media Relations Office in advance if you plan on attending a practice session so an escort can be made available. Daily practices typically run in the middle of the afternoon, with late practices being held on Mondays.

Weekly Release

The weekly release, or "game notes," regarding JU football is made available on Tuesday morning.

A copy of the notes will be placed on the JU Athletics Department web page at www.judolphins.com each Monday.

The release will be posted on the website in a portable document format (.pdf), will include notes, statistics and other pertinent information about that week's opponent and contest. These notes are also e-mailed to those media members on the JU Media Relations e-mail broadcast list.

1010XL - Home of the Dolphins

All JU broadcasts will be heard on 1010XL for the fourth straight season.

"We are very excited about our games being carried on 1010XL," said JU director of athletics Alan Verlander. "The station has strong leadership and has created a great buzz around the town. With their strong signal, it allows us to reach out to more fans in the area."

1010XL, the largest and highest rated sports talk station in Jacksonville has a 50,000-watt signal, is the flagship station of the JU Sports Network.

From The Airport/North

Traveling south on I-95 or from Jax International Airport: Take I-95 South one mile to 9A (I-295). Take 9A South across the St. John's River to Merrill Road. Exit on Merrill Road heading west. JU's campus entrance is at the end of Merrill Road at the intersection with University Blvd. Turn right onto University Blvd. and take the first entrance on the left. Go to media parking and follow the sidewalk north to the Ashley Sports Complex.

From The South

Traveling north on I-95: After passing I-295, exit onto Southside Blvd. (FL 115). Take Southside Blvd. North, merging with 9A North. On 9A North, look for the Merrill Road exit. Exit to the right (west). JU's campus entrance is at the end of Merrill Road at the intersection with University Blvd. Turn right onto University Blvd. and take the first entrance on the left. Go to media parking and follow the sidewalk north to the Ashley Sports Complex.

From The West

Traveling east on I-10: Merge with I-95 North. Exit onto Union Street heading east. Cross the St. John's River on the Mathews Bridge. The road becomes Arlington Expressway. Take first exit after the overpass, which is University Blvd. North. At the intersection of University Blvd. North and Merrill Road (about a mile), you will see the main University campus entrance. Cross the intersection and take the first entrance on the left. Go to media parking and follow the sidewalk north to the Ashley Sports Complex.



About Milne Field

Quick Facts

The first and only home for JU football is D.B. Milne Field, located on the JU campus.

Built in 1997 in preparation for the first JU football team, Milne Field was built after a gracious donation from D.B. Milne (for whom the field is named).

The first game at Milne Field came on Sept. 12, 1998 as JU beat Davidson, 19-14, for the school's first-ever win on the gridiron in front of a record crowd of 4,890.

In the summer of 2010, AstroTurf replaced the natural grass field.

Other firsts at Milne Field include:

- First overtime game - Oct. 16, 1999
(A 48-41 2OT win over Greensboro)
- First televised game - Sept. 12, 1998
(A 19-14 win over Davidson)
- First game against a ranked team - Sept. 8, 2001
(A 45-3 win over No. 3 Davidson)

Other tidbits about Milne Field:

- Longest JU home-field winning streak - 9
(Entering the upcoming season as JU won all five home games in 2009 and four games in 2010 ... 2010 game vs. Webber Intl. was at Bolles HS)
- Two of JU's overtime games have been played at home - the last time in 2000, a 17-14 win over Stoney Brook.
