19 seconds. It was the first time JU had the lead in the second half of a game since 16:27 at UAB.

The time previous to that was the final against Bethune-Cookman. JU held the lead in the second half just twice during the losing streak.

**Doubling Up:** Delwan Graham and Glenn Powell both had big nights against USC Upstate on Jan. 16. Each player recorded a double-double, the first time JU had two players record a double-double in a game since Marcus Allen and Lehmon Colbert accomplished the feat against Concordia on Nov. 17, 2007.

**BCS Busting:** The Dolphins have become a thorn in the side of BCS opponents. Last year, JU was 2-1 against teams from BCS leagues - including a 2-0 mark against the SEC. The Dolphins are 0-4 this season with losses to Alabama, Florida State, Florida and Marquette.

**Streaking, The Wrong Way:** Jacksonville ended the second longest losing streak in program history, 13 in a row, with a 77-74 win over USC Upstate on Jan. 16. It was the longest losing streak since JU dropped 25 in a row over the 2005-06 and 2006-07 seasons. Here's a look at the longest losing streaks in program history:

**Low Scoring Night:** Jacksonville posted just 45 points in its loss to Winthrop, setting a new low point total in the Cliff Warren. It is the third time in the Warren era that JU has been held to less than 50 points in a game.

The 45 points vs. Winthrop is tied for the 11th lowest scoring output in program history since 1957. The fewest points in a game is 31 - done twice (1960 and 1998).

**Long Streak Continues:** With its win over UNF on Feb. 8, 2011 JU tied the program record for longest winning streak over one opponent - set in 1965 with the 11th straight win over Rollins.

**Been a Long Time:** It's been a long time since JU has allowed 100 points in a game.

Florida's 107 points is the most allowed by the Dolphins since giving up 101 to the Gators back on Dec. 18, 2005 (JU lost 101-58 to the eventual national champions).

It is only the 19th time in program history that the Dolphins have allowed 100 points.

The loss also marked JU's first loss by more than 40 points since the 2005 trip to Florida. The 45-point loss is the second-largest margin in program history, with the record being a 46-point loss to South Alabama in the 1989 Sun Belt Conference title game.

**Making a Mark:** With five straight winning seasons, Cliff Warren is moving up the all-time wins list at JU.

Entering tonight's game, Warren has racked up 95 wins at JU - the third highest total in program history among the 15 head coaches. He needs 13 wins to become the school's all-time winningest head coach.

Tonight's game marks the 203rd of his head coaching career, placing him sec-

ond on the most games coached at JU. He needs 23 more to pass Hugh Durham for the record, which will have to wait until the 2012-13 season to be broken.

A sluggish start doomed the JU men's basketball team as Florida State held off a late rally for a 79-67 win.

The Dolphins (0-1) got a game-high 21 points from sophomore Keith McDougald, with 13 of that coming in the second half thanks to three 3-pointers.

FSU (1-0) used a long range barrage, hitting eight 3-pointers – led by Deividas Dulkys four en route to 16 points. The Seminoles had three players in double figures, with Michael Snaer adding 16 and Terrance Shannon adding 15 points and 12 rebounds off the bench.

"I was pleased with our effort to-

night," said JU head coach Cliff Warren. "Everyone contributed tonight, especially with two guys out tonight that shortened our bench."

Trailing by 13 at the half, JU fell behind by 16 early but cut the margin to 10, 47-37, on a jumper by Keith McDougald with 18:26 left in the game.

The Seminoles answered with a slow run to pull away, eventually leading by 24, before a late run cut the margin to 13 – thanks to seven straight points by McDougald at one point.

FSU held a slim 39-35 edge on the glass, with JU holding a 13-12 advantage in second chance points.

A late JU rally that looked for a moment to be enough to win was dashed on a buzzer beater in regulation with Savannah State taking advantage of its second life for a 73-70 win at Tiger Arena.

The Tigers (1-2) thrived at the free throw line in overtime, going 5-of-8, and surviving a 1-of-9 extra session, getting a 14 points from Rashad Hassan.

The late rally by Savannah State overshadows a career night from Aloys Cabell, who scored 22 points on 8-of-17 shooting for JU (0-2).
