YEAR IN REVIEW

The JU softball team is inching close to the summit of the Atlantic Sun after the Dolphins produced another successful season in 2010.

The Dolphins (33-23, 10-10 A-Sun) got off to their best start in school history with a 21-7 mark, which included a two wins over Virginia Tech and a winning record at all of their non-conference tournaments. They went 1-5 in their first six games in conference, but bounced back with a 9-5 record to secure their second straight A-Sun Tournament berth. JU finished with more than 30 wins for the first time since 2005 and posted the second-best home record in the with a 19-7 mark.

Along the way, the Dolphins also got a program-record five players of the all-conference teams, while setting new single-season records in ERA (2.11) and fielding percentage (.964).

Senior **Ashley Iveson** led the pitching staff with a career best 16 wins and 184 strikeouts in 157.2 innings to receive second team all-conference honors. Freshman **Olivia Kline** got all-freshman honors after recording a 0.81 ERA in A-Sun play. She also finished the year with a single-season low 1.73 ERA, while tallying a 10-7 record and 75 strikeouts.

Less than a year removed from a knee and shoulder injury, sophomore **Kayla Ouellet** earned first team all-conference honors after finishing the season with a team-best 66 hits, 32 runs and 16 stolen bases. She jumped to the team lead in hitting after a 10-for-21 effort (.476) with six RBI in five games at the USF Under Armour Invitational (3/5-7). Ouellet had a season-high three hits on four occasions during the first week of March and drove in two runs in four straight games (3/6-10). She was named to the A-Sun all-tournament team by batting a team-best .417 (5-12) in three starts while driving in the game-winning run in JU's extra-inning win against Campbell.

Senior **Amber Moseley** had a .353 (12-34) average in A-Sun action to get second team all-conference accolades, while freshman **Sarah Simon** tied for the team lead in home runs (6) and finished second with 25 RBI and 10 doubles to get all-freshman honors.

DOLPHIN NOTABLES

In 2010, the Dolphins set new single-season records in ERA (2.11) and fielding percentage (.964), while finishing second on the program list with 329 strikeouts and third in RBI with 175...the Dolphins recorded the second-best win total (33) in school history and finished with the best home record since the 2005 season with a 19-7 mark...JU began the season with a 21-7 record, the best start in school history...the Dolphins also had a six-game winning streak (3/14-23) which was just a game shy of the school record...the Dolphins recorded a winning record in all of their non-conference tournaments in 2010, including tallying two wins over 2008 Women's College World Series participant Virginia Tech...freshman **Olivia Kline** finished the year with a 0.81 ERA in A-Sun play en route to breaking the single-season ERA record with a 1.73 mark...senior **Ashley Iveson** set single-season records in wins (16), double-digit strikeout games (6) and strikeouts per contest (8.17)...Iveson also fell 11 strikeouts shy of passing **Katie Dobson** (194) for the single-season record...sophomore **Amanda Schmidt** (2/14), freshman **Sarah Simon** (3/10) and freshman **Olivia Kline** (3/19) each hit two home runs in one game in 2010. Prior to the season, no Dolphin had accomplished that feat in the previous seven years of the program...With the grand slam against USC Upstate (5/14), Simon also became the first Dolphin to get the feat since **Pat Melo** in 2007.

Ouellet earns A-Sun all-tournament honors

After being the top hitter during the season, sophomore Kayla Ouellet continued her pace for the Dolphins in the postseason en route to earning A-Sun All-Tournament honors.

The Orlando native batted a team-best .417 (5-12) in three starts while driving in the game-winning run in JU's extra-inning win over Campbell on May 13.

In 2010, Ouellet earned first team all-conference honors after finishing the season with a team-best 66 hits, 32 runs and 16 stolen bases. She jumped to the team lead in hitting after a 10-for-21 effort (.476) with six RBI in five games at the USF Under Armour Invitational (3/5-7). Ouellet had a season-high three hits on four occasions during the first week of March and drove in two runs in four straight games (3/6-10).

JU receives five all-conference selections

It continued to be a great year for the JU softball program as a school-record five players received A-Sun all-conference honors on May 11 from the league office.

Sophomore **Kayla Ouellet** received first team all-conference accolades to lead the group, while seniors **Ashley Iveson** and **Amber Moseley** each earned second team honors. Freshman battery mates **Olivia Kline** and **Sarah Simon** were each named to the all-freshman team to round out the Dolphins' honors.

Ouellet, who missed the 2009 season with a knee and shoulder injury, posted a team-best 61 hits, 31 runs and 16 stolen bases in 2010. She jumped to the team lead in hitting after a 10-for-21 effort (.476) with six RBI in five games at the USF Under Armour Invitational (3/5-7). Ouellet had a season-high three hits on four occasions during the first week of March and drove in two runs in four straight games (3/6-10). Recently, she recorded two hits and two runs in the Dolphins' win at Mercer (4/30).

Iveson got second team all-conference honors by posting team highs in strikeouts (175), wins (16) and innings pitched (175.0). Her 16 wins, as well as her six double-digit strikeout games, are single-season records. Iveson also had seven complete-game shutouts and only allowed one run in 30.2 innings of work from April 10 to May 4.

In A-Sun play, Moseley became the Dolphins' unexpected offensive leader with a .353 (12-34) average, three doubles and six RBI. She had a two-run homer to lead the Dolphins past Campbell (4/17), while also picking up key RBI hits in the two-game sweep against Kennesaw State on April 29.

Kline allowed only one earned run in the last 28 innings of relief and posted a team-best six home runs en route to all-freshman honors. Simon received her accolades after ranking second on the team in doubles (10) and home runs (5), while ranking third in RBI (21). She also batted 3-for-3 with three RBI and a home run to help JU down Mercer, 5-0, on April 30.

Dolphins earn four conference weekly honors

Along the same lines of the all-conference honors, the Dolphins had a program-record four players receive A-Sun weekly accolades during the 2010 season.

Sophomore **Amanda Schmidt** got the first A-Sun "Player of the Week" honor on Feb. 14 after recording seven RBI to lead Dolphins at the JU Tournament. She also had two home runs against UNC Greensboro to become the first JU player to hit multiple home runs in a single game.

Sophomore **Kayla Shavers** earned her honor on March 15 by going 9-for-17 (.529) with eight RBI, three runs, two doubles and a game-winning inside-the-park home run against Charleston Southern. **Junior Katie Kelly** batted .400 (8-20) to help the Dolphins to a 5-1 record for the accolades on April 12.

The Dolphins got their final honor on May 3 after senior **Ashley Iveson** recorded a 0.47 ERA and struck out 17 batters, while holding opponents to a .115 batting average in 15 innings of work in three appearances to get the lone "Pitcher of the Week" for JU.

Kline spells relief

Freshman Olivia Kline settled into the role as ace reliever of the Dolphins' pitching staff in 2010.

From April 1 to May 6, Kline allowed just one earned run in 28.0 relief innings during eight appearances. She logged four or more scoreless innings on three occasions, including getting the win at UNF (4.2 IP) and ETSU (5.0 IP). Kline pitched 26 straight scoreless relief frames before allowing a two-out RBI single in the sixth inning at UCF on May 4. She also posted two scoreless innings against Stetson (5/13) at the A-Sun Tournament to close out the contest.

Kline posted a team-best 0.81 ERA in A-Sun play en route to breaking the single-season ERA record with a 1.73 mark. She finished second on the team with 70 strikeouts and recorded a 10-7 record in 125.2 innings.

Kelly's strong play

Junior **Katie Kelly** squared the ball up nicely in the final part of the schedule to help the Dolphins secure their second straight berth to the A-Sun tournament.

From April 6-14th, Kelly batted .334 (11-32) with eight RBI, three runs, a double and a home run. She had a hit in eight of the 10 games and recorded an RBI in five different contests.

Kelly recorded a career-best four RBI with the help of a home run in the game two win over ETSU on April 10. She also added a homer in the home finale victory against Bethune-Cookman (4/14), while getting multiple hits on three different occasions.

Back from the dead

For a week and a half period, the Dolphins just couldn't do anything right.

From March 25 through April 2, the Dolphins went 1-7 overall, including a 1-5 mark in conference play. JU was outscored 38-14 and hit .206 compared to the opponent's .306 average. The Dolphin pitching staff suffered as well, posting a 4.41 ERA.

The Dolphins snapped out of their funk the following week (4/6-4/14) by tallying a 6-2 mark to even their conference record and jump five spots in the A-Sun standings.

Despite a .252 average, the Dolphins outscored their opponents 31-to-14 with 27 RBI. They also got good performances out of their pitching staff after the Dolphins recorded a stout 1.00 ERA.

Senior **Ashley Iveson** led the pitching staff during that span by posting a 4-1 mark with a 1.15 ERA and 32 strikeouts in 30.1 innings. Freshman **Olivia Kline** allowed just two earned runs in 24.1 innings of work, while junior **Katie Kelly** batted .423 (11-16) with two doubles, two home runs and eight RBI to pace the Dolphins at the plate.

Home sweet home

The Dolphins have done a great job this season of protecting their home field.

In 2010, the Dolphins finished with a 19-7 record, which is the second highest total in school history and a game shy of tying the program record of 20 wins set by the 2005 squad. The win total is also the best record under head coach **Amanda Lehotak**, surpassing her previous high mark of 12 wins in 2008.

The Dolphins began the year winning seven of their first eight home games, including an 11-7 victory over 2008 Women's College World Series participant Virginia Tech (2/13). After falling to No. 18 Florida State (2/24), JU recorded four more home victories before dropping its first doubleheader of the season to Georgia Southern (3/30).

The Dolphins closed out the home schedule winning five of their last six games, including consecutive double-headersweeps over ETSU (4/9) and USC Upstate (4/10). Below is a list of JU's home records since they started fast pitch softball in 2003:

Iveson is a strikeout artist

Senior right-handed pitcher Ashley Iveson painted the corners better than Picasso in 2010.

In 2010, Iveson had a career and team-best 184 strikeouts in 33 appearances, including six 10-plus strikeout efforts to break the school record of five set by **Katie Dobson** (2003-06) in 2003. She also broke the single-season mark for strikeouts per contest (8.17) en route to second team all-conference honors.

Iveson recorded 11 strikeouts in 5.1 scoreless relief innings against Presbyterian College on Feb. 21. She would fan 10 batters in her second complete-game shutout of the season against Eastern Kentucky on Feb. 26 before striking out 10 batters in JU's 8-0 win over Austin Peay (March 6). Iveson tied her career-high strikeouts with 13 in the win over FAMU (3/23). She recorded 12 strikeouts and scattered two hits for a complete-game shutout against Bethune-Cookman in her final home start as a Dolphin on April 14.

Iveson struck out 11 and scattered two hits in a complete-game shutout at Kennesaw State (4/29), which also set the single-season record for wins with her 16th victory.

For her career, Iveson holds the JU career record for strikeouts per game with a 6.04 average, while ranking second in strikeouts (420) and strikeouts looking (126). She also finished second all-time in shutouts (10) and third in wins (34) and appearances (115).

Dealing Aces

A good portion of the Dolphins' early success was the result of the pitching staff.

Through the first 14 games, the Dolphins posted a 1.74 ERA and were holding opponents to a .181 batting aver-

age. They recorded seven shutout wins, including three straight to sweep Presbyterian College (2/20-21).

Senior **Ashley Iveson** was the catalyst for the staff after recording a 1.52 ERA with just six earned runs and 32 strikeouts in 27.2 innings. She had a season-high 11 strikeouts against the Blue Hose (2/21) before fanning 10 batters against Coastal Carolina (2/28) to get her second complete-game shutout.

Sophomore **Sarah Sigrest** and freshman **Olivia Kline** each posted a 3-1 record through four starts. Kline retired 26 batters between near no-hitters against the Blue Hose (2/20) and Eastern Kentucky (2/26).

Sigrest recorded shutout wins against the Blue Hose (2/20) and Coastal Carolina (2/28), while senior **Brittany Abbott** didn't give up a run in her first two appearances this year.

Fresh starts

The Dolphins came out of the gates strong to start the 2010 campaign.

JU posted a 7-1 record through the first eight games, which ranks as the best start in school history. The start passed the 5-3 mark to open the 2004 season and the 4-4 record in the first eight games to start the 2008 campaign - Lehotak's second season at the helm. Last season, the Dolphins began the year 1-7 in the first eight games.

During this good start, JU batted .298 (61-205), while outscoring its opposition 33-15. The Dolphins pitching staff was equally impressive by recording five shutouts, including three straight against Presbyterian College (2/20-21). The staff also recorded 45 strikeouts and held opponents to a .173 batting average.

Junior **Katie Kelly** paced the Dolphins offensively after batting .381 (8-21) with five RBI. She had a hit in her last seven games and scored a team-best seven times. Sophomore **Amanda Schmidt** followed suit with a .375 clip (9-24), eight RBI and two home runs.

In the circle, three different Dolphins had at least two victories in the first eight games. Senior **Ashley Iveson** recorded a team-high 19 strikeouts, while freshman **Olivia Kline** pitched 10.1 scoreless innings.

With the hot start, the Dolphins ventured into more uncharted territory as they received votes in the Ultimate Collegiate Softball Poll on Feb. 23.

JU vs. the Top 25

The Dolphins played two top 25 opponents in the first two weeks of the season.

JU fell to No. 3 Florida, 6-1, in its final road trip of the year on Feb. 17, while the Dolphins suffered their first home loss to No. 18 Florida State, 8-0 (6), less than a week later.

The Dolphins now have a 2-24 all-time record against teams from the top 25. JU was winless in five games against ranked opponent last season.

The last win against a Top 25 team for JU came over No. 11 Florida State, 4-2, at home in 2004. They also downed No. 22 Southern Illinois, 2-0, less than a week before the Seminoles' win.

Youth is served

The Dolphins may have a veteran squad this season, but they have a new crop of players that will be counted on greatly as the season progresses.

Led by junior transfer **Annikie Don**, the Dolphins added new freshman battery mates P/IF **Olivia Kline** and C **Sarah Simon**, while also getting freshman outfielders **Lauren Even** and **Morgan Klüber**.

In JU's first tournament this season, Simon started in every game behind the plate, while Don played right field and Kline split time between first base and the circle.

Kelly named preseason all-conference

The Dolphins got their first honor of the 2010 season as junior shortstop **Katie Kelly** was named to the A-Sun preseason all-conference team.

As a sophomore, Kelly led the Dolphins offensively for the second consecutive year after tallying a .327 average (56-171), a .404 on-base percentage and scoring a team-best 30 runs. She recorded 43 of her 56 hits at the leadoff spot in the lineup and tallied a team-high 17 multi-hit games.

For her efforts, she earned first team all-conference honors and become the first player in school history to receive Louisville Slugger/National Fastpitch Coaches Association All-Region first team accolades.

Dolphins add four players for 2011

The Dolphins strengthened their lineup after adding four players, including local product **Brittany Eppley** (P/1B, Florida State College of Jacksonville), for the 2011 season.

Along with Eppley, OF **Miranda Fleming** (Omaha, Neb.), C **Karson Tuck** (Walkersville, Md.) and UT **Jacey Warner** (DeLand, Fla.) are set to join the Dolphins next season.

During the fall, Eppley finished with three home runs against the Dolphins to help the Stars and tossed a one-hit complete game shutout in her second start against JU.

JU picked 10th in A-Sun Coaches Poll

Despite recording the second best win total in 2009 and returning 14 players, the Dolphins were picked to finish 10th in the A-Sun preseason coaches' poll released by the conference office.

Lipscomb took the top spot with 111 points and five first-place votes, while also getting the nod as the tournament champion. Campbell, which won the 2009 A-Sun tournament, was selected second (106) followed by Mercer (91), Florida Gulf Coast (85) and USC Upstate (77) to make up the rest of the top five. Kennesaw State, UNF, ETSU, Stetson, JU and Belmont rounded out the rest of the poll.
